Big Idea: *God's love is patient. Ours should be, too.*

God's Love Is Patient.

Here are 4 ingredients to God's patient love for us, which we should grow in, too.

Questions for Discussion & Reflection

1. What stood out to you from the text/sermon?
2. Think about how you have experienced God's patient love for you. When did that happen? What did you learn through that experience?
3. Out of the 4 ingredients to bringing about a love that is patient (intentionality, faithfulness, humility, and expectation), which is the most difficult for you? Which comes most naturally? Pray that God grows your heart in all 4.
4. In what areas do you need to grow in to love patiently with family? With co-workers? With neighbors? Which group is the most challenging and why?
5. Spend time praying for one another by name. Ask the LORD to grow a love that is patient in each of you. Thank the LORD for the ways God's image is revealed through each person, allowing your time to linger patiently as God grows your heart for Him and one another.
