Love Is Not Arrogant or Rude | Trent Thompson

1 Corinthians 13:4-5

1. Arrogance divides a church, Love unifies it. (4:6-7)
2. Arrogance rejects godly authority, Love submits to it. (4:18-21)
3. Arrogance justifies evil, Love fights against it. (5:1-2)
4. Arrogance leads others astray, Love builds them up. (8:1)

Questions for Discussion & Reflection

1. What stood out to you from the sermon and the Scriptures?
2. Which of the four indicators of arrogance in I Corinthians do you see most in yourself?
3. Are there any other believers to whom you need to be reconciled? What will it take for this to happen? What keeps you from pursuing it?
4. Is there any area of your life where you have resisted having godly authority? Why and what steps could you take to change this?
5. Do you think you are justifying or tolerating evil in any area of your life? Why or why not?
6. Have you ever led someone else astray by a choice you've made? Why are we prone to want our way rather than to build someone else up by not having our way?
